RFP: Diamond Mountain Forest and Watershed Restoration Project Hand Pile Burning

Lassen Fire Safe Council, Inc. is requesting proposals for hand pile burning services from qualified contractors on the Diamond Mountain Forest and Watershed Restoration Project. The project area is approximately 4.5 miles south of Susanville, CA.

Project implementation is expected in the fall of 2023 with subsequent work as needed in the spring and fall of 2024. The project will involve burning hand piles during favorable conditions. Proposers shall be individuals or firms providing prescribed fire management services including all labor, materials, equipment, tools, PPE, transportation and supplies required to complete the work. Prescribed fire burning guidelines, a prescribed fire burn plan, and burn bosses will be provided by the US Forest Service Lassen National Forest.

Sealed proposals will be received in person at the Lassen Fire Safe Council office at 1825 Main Street Susanville, CA 96130, or by mail at PO Box 816 Susanville, CA 96130 by September 21, 2023 at 5:00 pm.

Lassen Fire Safe Council, Inc. will evaluate proposals submitted according to the information found in the proposal package. Proposals will only be accepted from contractors who demonstrate an ability to successfully complete the scope of work being bid and have valid required insurances and licenses in effect at the time of submission.
